REPUBLICAN CANDIDATES OFFER FULL SUPPORT FOR TOM LARSON

[Chippewa Falls, WI] - Candidates from Tuesday's Republican primary election announced their support for small business owner Tom Larson today at the Chippewa County Republican Party headquarters. Larson received 30% of the vote in a six-way primary this past week and was humbled and honored to receive the Republican nomination from the people of the 67th Assembly District.

"I'm proud to be a part of this fine group of individuals," commented Larson on the group of contenders from Tuesday's Republican primary. "We all had a common goal in this primary election and will have a common goal in November.
